**Renewal of Determination [2011] IASC 106**

Thank you for your recent letter which invited Qantas to express its interest in the renewal of Determination [2011] IASC 106, which allocates 2,121 seats per week on the Taiwan route and expires on 6 June 2016.

We seek to have Determination [2011] IASC 106 varied in order to hand back 861 seats and retain 1,260 seats for a further five years from 7 June 2016.

We also seek the following additions to the existing conditions in the determination:

- Capacity may be utilised by Qantas or another Australian carrier which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Qantas; and
- Capacity may be used by Qantas to provide joint services with any wholly-owned subsidiary and by any wholly owned subsidiary of Qantas to provide joint services with Qantas.

We would be pleased to provide any further information the Commission might require in considering our renewal request.
