#### 1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 1 December 2009 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2007] IASC 123 which allocates 17.5 tonnes of freight capacity per week on the Papua New Guinea route under the Australia – Papua New Guinea air services arrangements. Qantas advised that Express Freighters Australia no longer planned to operate services between points in Australia and Port Moresby in the near future.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

#### 2 Delegate's consideration

2.1 In accordance with section 27AB of the Act and regulation 3A of the *International Air Services Commission Amendment Regulations 2003 (No.1)*, the delegate of the Commission considers the Qantas application.

2.2 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA (3) of the Act).

#### 3 Decision ([2009] IASC 220)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act the delegate, on behalf of the Commission, revokes Determination [2007] IASC 123.
