[2009] IASC 101 – Vietnam Route

This determination, as varied by Decision 2009/221, allocates one frequency per week of dedicated freight capacity on the Vietnam route.

Renewal of this determination is requested for a further five years from 13 January 2014. Qantas continues to monitor the market for freight services on the Vietnam route and seeks renewal on the basis that the capacity will be fully utilised by 31 December 2016.

[2008] IASC 121 – China Route

This determination, as varied by decision 2010/203, allocates 2,301 seats per week in each direction on the China route and includes conditions to permit joint services with China Eastern Airlines. There is a small amount of unused capacity to allow for aircraft substitution.

Qantas seeks renewal of this determination for a further five years from 2 March 2014.

[2009] IASC 104 – Indonesia Route

Qantas is fully utilising this determination which allocates 389 seats per week on the Indonesia route and four passenger services per week beyond Indonesia.

We therefore seek renewal of this determination for a further five years from 3 April 2014.
