### **Application for Variation – Hong Kong**

Qantas is seeking a variation of capacity allocations on the Hong Kong route to enable Jet Airways to code share on Qantas operated services between Australia and Hong Kong.

A copy of the confidential code share agreement between Qantas and Jet Airways will be provided prior to the commencement of the code share services.

### Variation Sought

Qantas requests a variation to Determination 123/2009, Determination 116/2011 and Determination 117/2011, which together allocate a total of 25 frequencies on the Hong Kong route, to enable Jet Airways to code share on Qantas services.

The variation is requested for the duration of each of the determinations.

### IASC Act and Policy Statement Considerations

This application should be considered against the general criteria for assessing the benefit to the public in paragraph 4 of the Minister's Policy Statement.

These state that the use of entitlements by an Australian carrier under a bilateral arrangement is of benefit to the public, provided that it is reasonably capable of obtaining the necessary approvals and implementing the proposal.
