Re: Renewal of Commission Determinations

I refer to your letter of 16 October 2017, inviting us to express our interest in the renewal of those determinations allocating capacity to Virgin Australia International Airlines Pty Ltd (Virgin Australia) which are due to expire within the next 12 months.

Indonesia route – [2013] IASC 116

Virgin Australia continues to operate services to Indonesia utilising capacity allocated under [2013] IASC 116. We therefore seek renewal of this Determination (as varied by [2015] IASC 208) for a period of five years from 8 October 2018.

In addition to the retention of all relevant current conditions, we request that the new determination allows such capacity to be utilised for code share services with Delta Air Lines.

Indonesia route – [2013] IASC 117

Virgin Australia continues to operate services to Indonesia utilising capacity allocated under [2013] IASC 117. We therefore seek renewal of this Determination for a period of five years from 25 October 2018.

In addition to the retention of all relevant current conditions, we request that the new determination allows such capacity to be utilised for code share services with Delta Air Lines.
