Application for variation – Indonesia route

Virgin Australia International Airlines Pty Ltd (Virgin Australia) is seeking to vary a number of its determinations on the Indonesia route, to provide increased flexibility for the utilisation of these capacity allocations.

Variation sought

Virgin Australia requests that the following determinations it holds on the Indonesia route are varied to authorise the utilisation of such capacity by another Australian carrier which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Virgin Australia. IASC Act and Minister's Policy Statement considerations

We request that the Commission consider this application against the general criteria for assessing the benefit to the public in Paragraph 4 of the Minister's Policy Statement.

The Paragraph 4 criteria provide that the use of entitlements by an Australian carrier under a bilateral air services agreement is of benefit to the public, provided that the carrier is reasonably capable of obtaining the necessary approvals and implementing the proposal.
