1 The application

1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 10 September 2010 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determinations [2006] IASC 102 and [2008] IASC 108 which allocate three frequencies per week and two frequencies per week respectively on the Vietnam route. Qantas advised that, following a review of the Group's plans for the Vietnam route, there is no immediate intention to operate direct services between Australia's gateway points and Vietnam.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Delegate's consideration

2.1 In accordance with section 27AB of the Act and regulation 3A of the *International Air Services Commission Amendment Regulations 2003 (No.1)*, the delegate of the Commission considers the Qantas application.

2.2 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA (3) of the Act).

3 Decision ([2010] IASC 207)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act the delegate, on behalf of the Commission, revokes Determinations [2006] IASC 102 and [2008] IASC 108.
