I refer to your letter of 24 August 2015 inviting Virgin Australia International Airlines Pty Ltd (Virgin Australia) to express its interest in the renewal of Determination [2011] IASC 110 (as varied by [2011] IASC R10 and [2012] IASC 204), which allocates 2,800 seats per week of capacity on the Indonesia route and is due to expire on 29 August 2016.

Virgin Australia continues to fully utilise the capacity allocated by Determination [2011] IASC 110 to operate our services to Indonesia. We wish to retain this allocation and request that the conditions of the determination are varied to authorise the utilisation of the capacity by another Australian carrier which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Virgin Australia. Accordingly, Virgin Australia seeks renewal of Determination [2011] IASC 110, subject to amended conditions as requested, for a period of five years from 30 August 2016.
