Application for Capacity – New Caledonia route

Effective during the Northern Summer scheduling season, commencing 31 March 2019, Qantas Airways Limited (Qantas) plans to operate one additional weekly service between Australia and New Caledonia using B737 aircraft.

For flexibility, the ability for another Australian carrier which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Qantas, such as Jetstar Airways Pty Limited, to utilise capacity on the route is requested.

Allocation Sought

Qantas seeks an allocation of 156 seats per week on the New Caledonia route on the following basis:

- the allocation is for a period of five years from the date of the determination;
- the capacity will be fully used by 30 July 2019;
- the capacity may be utilised by Qantas or another Australian carrier which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Qantas;
- the capacity may be used to by Qantas to provide joint services with any wholly-owned subsidiary and by any wholly-owned subsidiary of the Qantas Group to provide joint services with Qantas; and
- the capacity may be used by Qantas to provide services jointly with Aircalin.

We would be pleased to provide any further information the Commission may require.
