Qantas/Jetstar Asia Code Share Services

Qantas plans to commence code share arrangements with Jetstar Asia from 1 June 2011 or as soon as all necessary approvals have been received.

Under these arrangements, it is proposed that Qantas will place its code on Jetstar Asia's services between Singapore and the following points:

Kuala Lumpur vv;
Penang vv;
Hong Kong vv;
Bangkok vv;
Phuket vv;
Taipei vv;
Ho Chi Minh City vv; and
New Zealand vv.

A copy of the code share agreement and amendment agreement between Qantas and Jetstar Asia is set out in the Attachment for your records. As there are confidentiality restrictions contained within the Agreement, this material is provided to the International Air Services Commission (the Commission) on a strictly commercial-in-confidence basis.

Allocation sought

Qantas seeks an allocation of fourteen frequencies per week and 2,121 weekly seats of capacity to be used for third country code share services on the Thailand and Taiwan routes respectively, on the following basis:

- the allocation will be fully used by 1 June 2011.


IASC Act and Policy Statement Considerations
