HeavyLift Cargo Airlines (ABN 16 102 571 746) respectfully requests unlimited all-cargo capacity to operate services between Australia and Singapore from 15 February 2012. This capacity will be utilized with an aircraft from the United States with 50,000kg payload capacity. The operator currently holds all necessary United States and Australian regulatory requirements. This allocation will be used in conjunction with our Port Moresby Service into and out of both Brisbane and Cairns. We seek the allocation for a period of 10 years with one service per week.


Designation Status

HeavyLift Cargo Airlines is a designated Australian all-cargo carrier to Papua New Guinea and the Solomon Islands. As such this capacity between Singapore and Australia will enhance the HeavyLift network for cargo originating from Singapore destined for Australia and Port Moresby.
