## 1 The application

- 1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 13 November 2007 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2004] IASC 108 which allocated 2.4 units of capacity per week under the Australia Japan air services arrangements. Qantas has withdrawn its seasonal services to Sapporo.
- 1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

#### 2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3) of the Act).
