# 1 The application

- 1.1 Qantas applied to the Commission on 13 November 2007 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2003] IASC 122 which allocates 200 third-party code share seats per week under the Australia Greece air services arrangements. The request follows the withdrawal by Gulf Air of its services to Australia, on which Qantas code shared to Bahrain and on to Athens.
- 1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

### 2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA(3) of the Act).

# 3 Decision ([2007] IASC 220)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determination [2003] IASC 122.
