#### 1 The application

1.1 Virgin Blue applied to the Commission on 29 November 2010 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2009] IASC 107 which allocates 540 seats per week in each direction and three frequencies per week of passenger capacity beyond Indonesia, all three of which may service Denpasar, on the Indonesia route. Virgin Blue advised that it had decided not to seek an extension of time to utilise the capacity.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

#### 2 Delegate's consideration

2.1 In accordance with section 27AB of the Act and regulation 3A of the *International Air Services Commission Amendment Regulations 2003 (No.1)*, the delegate of the Commission considers the Virgin Blue application.

2.2 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA (3) of the Act).

#### 3 Decision ([2010] IASC 212)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act the delegate, on behalf of the Commission, revokes Determination [2009] IASC 107.
