1 The application

1.1 V Australia applied to the Commission on 1 April 2011 to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act), Determination [2008] IASC 113 which allocates five services per week of capacity on the South Africa route under the Australia – South Africa air services arrangements. V Australia advised that it will not be using its allocation of capacity.

1.2 Material supplied by the applicant is filed on the Register of Public Documents.

2 Commission's consideration

2.1 If an Australian carrier asks the Commission to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination (section 27AA (3) of the Act). The Commission notes that V Australia withdrew from the South Africa route in February 2011.

3 Decision ([2011] IASC 206)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determination [2008] IASC 113.
