1 The application

1.1 Pacific Wings Pty Ltd (Pacific Wings) applied to the Commission on 7 May 2013 to revoke Determination [2009] IASC 111 which allocates unlimited passenger capacity on the New Zealand route.

2 Delegate's consideration

2.1 In accordance with section 27AB of the Act and regulation 3A of the International Air Services Commission Regulations 1992, the delegate of the Commission may consider the application by Pacific Wings. (For purposes of this instrument, all references to the Commission include the delegate of the Commission).

2.2 Under subsection 27AA(1) of the Act, an Australian carrier, to whom a determination allocating capacity is issued, may at any time request the Commission to revoke the determination.

2.3 Upon receipt of an application to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination pursuant to subsection 27AA(3).

3 Decision ([2013] IASC 219)

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission's delegate revokes Determination [2009] IASC 111 with effect from the date this instrument is made.
