## Application for Variation - Papua New Guinea

Qantas is seeking a variation of capacity allocations on the Papua New Guinea route to enable reciprocal code sharing with Air Niugini, planned from 30 October 2016. Under new free sale arrangements, Qantas plans to code share on passenger services operated by Air Niugini between Port Moresby and Brisbane / Sydney / Cairns, while Air Niugini plans to code share on Qantas operated passenger services between Brisbane and Port Moresby.

Qantas and Air Niugini also have an agreement in place in relation to belly-hold freight on the route.

A signed copy of the confidential code share agreement between Qantas and Air Niugini will be provided to the Commission separately.

## **Variation Sought**

Qantas requests a variation to Determination 105/2014, Determination 132/2011 as varied and Determination 110/2016, which allocates a total of 1,888 seats per week for passenger services on the Papua New Guinea route, to permit the capacity to be used to code share with Air Niugini.

The variation is requested for the duration of the Determinations.
