**Application for Variation – Singapore**

As part of a code share agreement between Qantas and KLM Royal Dutch Airlines (KLM), it is proposed that KLM will offer code share services on flights operated by Qantas on the Singapore route.

It is planned that the code share arrangement will be available for booking from 24 October for travel from 30 October 2018.

A copy of the confidential code share agreement between Qantas and KLM will be provided separately to the Commission.

**Variation Sought**

Qantas requests a variation to Determination [2007] IASC 116 (as varied) and its subsequent renewal under Determination [2017] IASC 131 to permit the utilisation of capacity for code share services with KLM on the Singapore route.

The variation is requested for the duration of the determinations.
