### **Renewal of Determination**

Qantas Airways Limited (Qantas) appreciates the opportunity to express its interest in the renewal of Determination [2015] IASC 115 (as varied) allocating capacity to Qantas which will expire in the next 12 months.

Qantas continues to fully utilise the capacity allocated under this Determination in operating services to Hong Kong. We, therefore, seek renewal of this Determination for a period of five years from 22 November 2020, including the following existing conditions:

- the capacity may be utilised by Qantas or another Australian carrier which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Qantas;
- the capacity may be used by Qantas to provide joint services with any wholly-owned subsidiary and by any wholly-owned subsidiary of the Qantas Group to provide joint services with Qantas; and
- the capacity may be used by Qantas to provide services under code share agreements with British Airways, Finnair, Air France, LATAM Airlines and EI AI Airlines.

We note that the Commission already holds copies of each of Qantas' confidential code share agreements with British Airways, Finnair, Air France, LATAM Airlines and EI AI Airlines.
