Application for Variation – Thailand Route

Qantas Airways Limited (Qantas) plans to expand code share agreements with Société Air France (Air France) and KLM Royal Dutch Airlines (KLM).

Under these agreements, it is proposed that Air France and KLM will code share on Qantas operated services on the Thailand route (Sydney-Bangkok v.v.).

It is planned that the expanded code share agreements with Air France and KLM, which will operate on a free sale basis, will commence on 1 December 2019.

A copy of the confidential amended code share agreements will be provided separately to the Commission.

Variations Sought

Qantas requests the following variations of Determination [2017] IASC 108 (as varied) on the Thailand route:

- the capacity may be used for code share services with Air France; and
- the capacity may be used for code share services with KLM.

The variations are requested for the duration of the determination.
