Application for Capacity Allocation – Indonesia Route

Qantas' wholly-owned subsidiary company Jetstar Airways (Jetstar) plans to introduce additional services between Australia and Indonesia from November 2012.

The services will be operated using one-class A320 aircraft and two-class A330 aircraft.

Allocation Sought

Qantas seeks an allocation of 7,350 seats per week on the Indonesia Route on the following basis:

- the allocation is requested for a period of five years from the date of the determination;
- the capacity will be fully used by 1 April 2014;
- the capacity may be utilised by Qantas or another Australian carrier which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Qantas; and
- the capacity may be used to provide joint services with Qantas or any whollyowned subsidiary of the Qantas Group.
