Application for Allocation of Freight Capacity - Fiji Route

Pacific Air Express Australia Pty Ltd (PAE) proposes operating a weekly scheduled freighter service between Australia and Fiji, with a planned commencement date of 15th January 2012. The routing will be Brisbane-Nadi-Brisbane.

PAE will operate these services using a B737-300F ACMI leased from Toll/Airwork. The aircraft has a payload of 17500kg GW.

Allocation Sought

Pacific Air Express seeks an allocation of 17.5 tonnes per week on the Fiji route on the following basis:

- 1. The capacity will be utilised by Pacific Air Express Australia Pty Limited
- 2. The capacity will be fully used by 30 February 2012
- 3. The allocation is requested for a period of five years

IASC Act and Policy Statement Considerations

PAE believes this application meets the general criteria for assessing the benefit to the public in paragraph 4 of the Minister's statement.

The Paragraph 4 criteria provides that the use of entitlements by an Australian carrier under a bilateral air service agreement is of benefit to the public, provided that the carrier is reasonably capable of obtaining the necessary approvals and implementing the proposed services.
