Re: Renewal of Commission Determinations

I refer to your letter of 29 May 2013, regarding the renewal of determinations we hold for the Indonesia route which are due to expire within the next 12 months.

## Determination [2009] IASC 105

Virgin Australia continues to fully utilise capacity allocated by Determination [2009] IASC 105 to operate our services to Denpasar, Indonesia. We wish to retain this allocation and therefore seek renewal of the abovementioned determination for a period of five years from 11 May 2014.

In applying for this renewal, we note that the Register of Available Capacity provides that there are 1,972 seats per week in each direction available for allocation to Australian airlines for the operation of services between Indonesia and Sydney, Melbourne (including Avalon), Brisbane or Perth, together with an additional 2,500 seats per week in each direction provided services are operated via or beyond to a point in Australia other than Sydney, Melbourne (including Avalon), Brisbane or Perth. Furthermore, the Commission has acknowledged the strong growth recorded on the Indonesia route in recent years in Determination [2013] IASC 127. To ensure that Virgin Australia has the flexibility to respond to future growth within the market, we wish to retain all of the capacity we hold on the route, including the 1,080 seats allocated by Determination [2009] IASC 105.

## Determination [2009] IASC 106

Virgin Australia is seeking renewal of its allocation of unlimited capacity on the Indonesia route between points in Australia, other than Sydney, Melbourne (including Avalon), Brisbane and Perth and authorised points in Indonesia, for a period of five years from 27 May 2014. This will support the continued operation of our services between Adelaide and Denpasar.
