APPLICATION FOR CAPACITY – KOREA ROUTE

From 1 February 2024, Qantas' wholly-owned subsidiary Jetstar Airways Pty Limited (Jetstar) plans to launch scheduled services between Brisbane and Seoul (Incheon).

Jetstar will operate three flights per week using Boeing 787 aircraft configured with 335 seats. The flight schedule is provided below.

JQ54 Seoul (Incheon)-Brisbane	0050	1100	Wednesday, Friday, Sunday

Allocation Sought

Qantas seeks an allocation of 1,005 seats per week in each direction on the Korea route on the following basis:

- for a period of five years from the date of the determination;
- the capacity will be fully utilised by 31 March 2024;
- the capacity may be utilised by Qantas, Jetstar or another Australian carrier which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Qantas; and
- the capacity may be used by Qantas to provide joint services with any wholly-owned subsidiary and by any wholly-owned subsidiary of the Qantas Group to provide joint services with Qantas.

We request that this application be considered against the 'reasonable capability criterion' as defined in section 8 of the Minister's Policy Statement.
