Renewal of Determinations

Thank you for your letter of 4 November 2021 in relation to consideration of a renewal of the determination, [2016] IASC 1112, which allocates capacity to Virgin Australia Airlines (SE Asia) Pty Ltd (Virgin Australia) for the Fiji route.

Virgin Australia wishes to advise that it is seeking to renew the determination made on 19 December 2016 for a period of five years from 4 November 2022.

Subject to the revision of dates in the current determination, Virgin Australia does not propose any other changes to the conditions which have previously been set by the Commission.

Virgin Australia also asks the Commission to note that it is planning to resume services to Fiji this year commencing with Sydney on 16 December 2021 and Melbourne on 17 December 2021. This will be the first time Virgin Australia has provided Fiji services since March 2020.

Please note that Virgin Australia will continue to regularly review the opportunity to re-commence short and long-haul international services and respond to the latest advice.
